

FSRC Qi Men Dun Jia Online Course

Qi Men Dun Jia is one of the three "styles" of divination developed in ancient China. This course is conducted online with a Qi Men Dun Jia Handbook that provides detailed background materials. The online sessions are conducted at my Webex site with powerpoint presentation and live video. The seminar is recorded from beginning to end and put into an ebook. Each 1 hour session will be about 100 mb. The handbook is added chapter by chapter so that students have ample time to grasp the materials to follow the online seminars with ease.

Eight Doors




The eight doors move in the **clockwise** sense in the order:
 Rest, Injury, Birth, Delusive, View, Death, Shocking, Open.

The sequence can start with any door. The starting door is the Messenger on Duty 值使.

Focus (Yong Shen)




In QMDJ, there are 64 spirits we can use as the focus. These are:

- 10 stems
- 12 branches
- 8 trigrams
- 9 palaces
- 8 doors
- 9 stars
- 8 spirits

Comparing to Wan Wang Gua that uses 5 relations together with Subject and Object totalling 7 spirits for the focus, QMDJ is very complicated indeed. However, life is just complicated and the focus can be looked at from different angles to get a clearer picture.

Introduction




The main difference between QMDJ and other forms of divination is that the former analyzes the qi interaction in a specified space at a specified time while the latter depends on the process of communication between the diviner and the Universe. In a way, QMDJ is more scientifically oriented.

Since QMDJ looks at a situation from various angles or even in various dimensions, in this course, we will develop the technique at different stages. We will begin with a stage with rigid rules that can even be computerized. Later we will develop more sophisticated technique that depends more and more on the ability of the individual using QMDJ.

Despite this, we will use the term "divine (Zhan 占) in QMDJ.
